
What is Co-AGE Volunteers?

Co-AGE Volunteers is a Slovak-Austrian project with the aim to strengthen youth volunteering, especially in relation to volunteering with older people, in a sustainable and cross-border way.

We started our work in January 2021 to support and inspire young volunteers and volunteer organisations through a balanced package of strategies, action plans, trainings and guidelines until the end of 2022.

We have already achieved a lot and we hope that our results will be used, disseminated, complemented and further developed in the long run. We count on the Co-AGE Volunteers Network - a cross-border cooperation of Slovak and Austrian organisations, stakeholders, volunteers and coordinators, citizens' initiatives, etc. - to help us achieve this goal.

Dialogue, exchange of experiences, joint learning and teaching - these are the activities that make up the Co-AGE Volunteers Network.

The vision of our project is to establish a cross-border network of regional actors to sustainably support the engagement of young volunteers and to promote intergenerational solidarity and transnational volunteering of young people in the border region in line with the EU Youth Strategy.

The Co-AGE Volunteers Network is created through a cross-border, sustainable and multidisciplinary cooperation of Slovak and Austrian organisations focusing on youth education, volunteer coordination or intergenerational solidarity, supported by the project's own Youth Volunteering Strategy, Action Plan and educational activities.














